As of now, anyone seeking services from the Barbados Immigration Department must make an appointment to do so. This new system applies to all passport and immigration applications. However, those requiring urgent passports or making payments don't need appointments. Appointments can be scheduled through the department's website. Acting Chief Immigration Officer Margaret Inniss advises that customers needing urgent passports should call 535-4150 or 832-4102. The public is asked to comply with this new system as walk-ins will not be accepted. Only those conducting business with the department will be allowed entry. Additionally, all COVID-19 protocols must be followed, including temperature checks, hand sanitization, mask-wearing, and maintaining a six-foot distance from others. These measures are in response to the global pandemic and prioritize staff and visitor health and safety at the Barbados Immigration Department. Government of Barbados Launches Online Services for Citizens Minister of Home Affairs Wilfred Abrahams spoke at the launch ceremony, saying that the Immigration Department has made significant progress in providing high-quality services. The department has undergone a transformation, and the backlog is almost zero. This shift was possible due to a change in attitude within the department, which now works as part of a larger government effort. The Government of Barbados has introduced online application forms to make interactions between citizens and the government more efficient, accessible, and secure. These forms can be accessed using a desktop computer, tablet, or mobile device and submitted online. Travellers must complete the online Immigration and Customs Form 72 hours prior to their arrival. The form should be filled out at a convenient time and place and saved or printed for presentation upon arrival. Using the online ED Form will enhance your travel experience by providing an easy and convenient option that improves transit through the airport. Citizens can apply for a passport from the Immigration Department in Barbados or at one of the country's diplomatic missions abroad. To schedule an appointment, click on the link provided. To apply for a passport, complete Form A in your own handwriting using block letters, except for your signature. Children under 16 should use Form B. The application must be accompanied by two photographs taken by a professional photographer, and one photograph must be certified by a guarantor. Original birth certificates or proof of identity are also required. Applicants without a birth certificate must obtain one from the Registration Office at the Supreme Court Complex in White Park Road, St. Michael, Barbados. To find out the passport fees for diplomatic missions abroad, check with the relevant mission directly as rates differ between them. The updated passport fees since December 01, 2010 are as follows: For a Barbadian adult passport, it costs BDS \$150; for minors under 16, it's BDS \$100; businessmen passports are at BDS \$225; emergency or travel documents and replacement of lost passports also vary in cost but can go up to BDS \$300. Furthermore, urgent passports required within 1 day or 2-5 days come with different fees, which are set at BDS \$300 and BDS \$225 respectively.
